Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated was founded on the simple belief that sorority elitism and socializing should not overshadow the real mission for progressive organizations - to address societal mores, ills, prejudices, poverty, and health concerns of the day. Zeta chapters and auxiliary groups have given millions hours of voluntary service to educate the public, assist youth, provide scholarships, support organized charities and promote legislation for social change.



Signature Programs

- **Z-HOPE - Zetas Helping Other People Excel™** is an interactive, holistic and multidimensional outreach service initiative designed to enhance, cultivate and empower participants to develop health promoting lifestyle choices across the lifespan.
- **Stork's Nest** - A partnership with the [March of Dimes](#) in an effort to encourage women to seek prenatal care.
- **National Educational Foundation** (Human Genome Project) - Begun formally in 1990 as the Human Genome Project is a 13 year effort coordinated by the U.S. Department of Energy and the National Institutes of Health research and collect data, disseminate information and address ethical concerns related to the mapping of the human DNA.

Delta Alpha Zeta Chapter was organized April 22, 1949 by charter members Founder Fannie Pettie Watts, Dr. S.
